

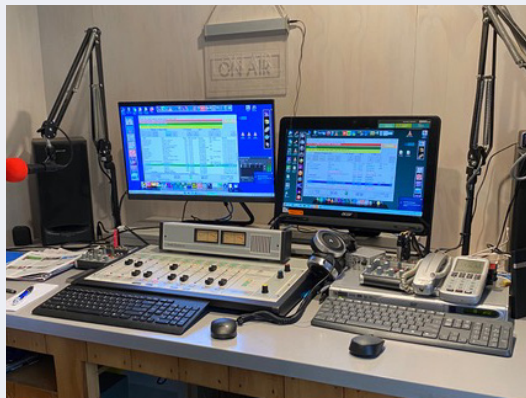
Since 2018 the Trust has met twice annually to review applications from the community for funding support. Since that time the Trust has distributed \$60,000 to community projects.
